A simple Uncial script for beginners

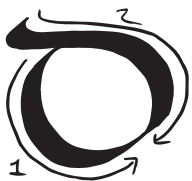
Once you are comfortable with the basic forms try adding some variations.

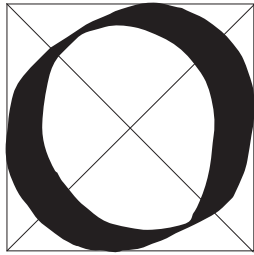

The uncial script dates from the 4th to 8th century and, in a basic form, provides an easy introduction to historic penmanship and a good foundation with which to start medieval calligraphy.

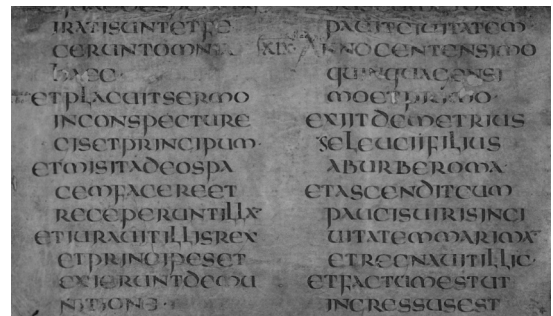
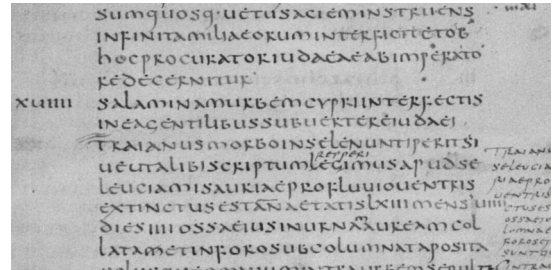
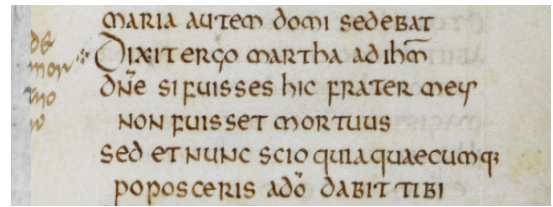


Pen angle should be twenty degrees.



The body of the letters should mostly be circular in form and the same width and height.

The numbers and arrows indicate the order and direction of the pen strokes
